CNCF Governing Board Action Taken by Electronic Voting

The Falco project requested an exception (See <u>Issue #629</u>) to the CNCF IP Policy for use of the following libraries:

- 1. <u>libcurl</u>, under the <u>curl</u> license
- 2. uthash, under the BSD-1-Clause license
- 3. <u>libelf</u> (component of elfutils), under the <u>LGPL-3.0-or-later</u> license, with some header files under <u>LGPL-2.1-or-later</u>.

On January 30, 2024, the CNCF Legal Committee (LC) recommended that the Governing Board:

- 1. APPROVE the requested license exception for <u>libcurl</u>
- 2. APPROVE the requested license exception for uthash
- 3. APPROVE the requested license exception for <u>libelf</u> *for dynamic linking only* (but not for static linking at this time)

During a voting period that commended on January 31, 2024 and closed on February 12, 2024, the CNCF Governing Board voted by email to:

- 1. APPROVE the requested license exception for libcurl
- 2. APPROVE the requested license exception for uthash
- 3. APPROVE the requested license exception for libelf *for dynamic linking only* (but not for static linking at this time)
