# KubeCon + CloudNativeCon India 2024

It was truly an honor to host our first ever KubeCon + CloudNativeCon India, a sold out event with 3,000+ attendees who were warm and enthusiastic about all things cloud native. We came into this with high expectations - after all, India is the fourth most active CNCF contributing country (with 11.5 thousand contributions) and it's the third highest ranking for committers - but even so, this was an impressive KubeCon + CloudNativeCon debut in Delhi.

From AI and machine learning to edge computing, security, and observability, attendees heard firsthand from practitioners around the globe in a community-curated mix of keynotes, breakout and maintainer sessions, and lightning talks. The networking continued before, during, and after the conference because, with ten years of Kubernetes (KuberTENes) colliding with AI, there was a lot to discuss.

Going forward, there will be even more open source to talk about because the Linux Foundation announced the establishment of LF India, created to foster open collaboration for Indian open source developers, enterprises and government organizations. Think of LF India as the "sandbox for innovation" in the region, which is incredibly exciting to all of us at CNCF.

It was great to look back at KubeCon + CloudNativeCon India, and I hope you'll also enjoy the opportunity. I look forward to seeing you at a CNCF event in 2025!

The event also garnered exceptional media attention, with representation from six top-tier Indian Publications with numerous senior-level technology journalists attended, further amplifying the event's importance. As of the end of December, the event received over 38 original articles, with over 70% from top tier publications, reaching audiences with significant unique visitor metrics (UVMs). This highlights the strong appeal and value of the event's content, which resonated widely with the tech media.
